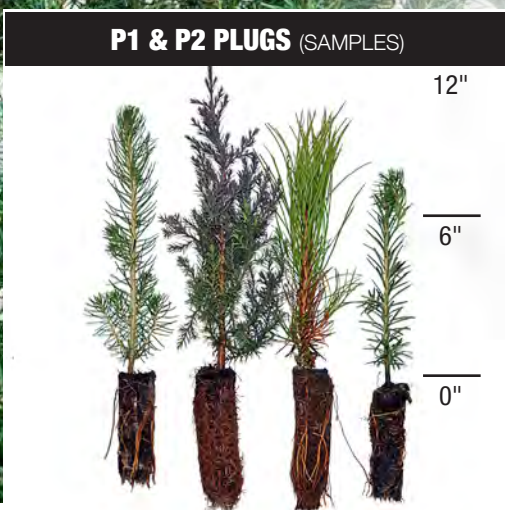
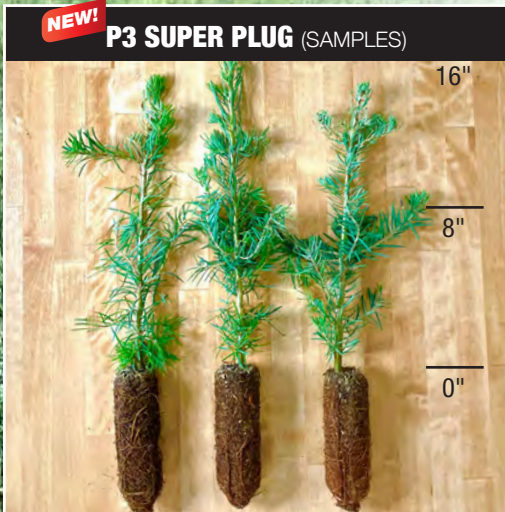

BALSAM FIR *Abies balsamea*: The classic short-needled Christmas tree. Shears very well and has a wonderful fragrance. Shiny, soft green needles and boughs make this a favorite of wreath makers. Likes well-drained, cool areas. May grow up to 12" annually under ideal conditions. 50-70'H x 20-25'W : Zones 3-5

CANAAN FIR *Abies balsamea var phanerolepis*: This elegant fir with dark green to bluish fragrant needles is a fine choice for Christmas tree production. With dense foliage it is stunning in groups or as a specimen. In all but the wettest conditions, Canaan Fir is grown successfully in most soils except heavy, wet clay. With a later bud break, spring frost injury is less likely than that of Fraser and Balsam. Good drought tolerance once established. 45-55'H x 15-25'W : Zones 4-7

CONCOLOR FIR *Abies concolor*: With long lasting needles, the Concolor, or White Fir is a great Christmas tree choice! Widely used in home landscape, it is generally disease and pest resistant. Citrus scented blue-green needles. Good nesting and shelter for game birds, song birds and small mammals. 30-50'H x 15-25'W : Zones 3-7

DOUGLAS FIR *Pseudotsuga menziesii*: We have the Lincoln variety which features blue-green to green needles. Makes a sweetly scented Christmas tree. Likes moist, well-drained soil and full sun, in areas protected from the wind. Severe damage from deer is seldom. 60-80'H x 12-20'W : Zones 4-6

FRASER FIR *Abies fraseri*: The Cadillac of long lasting Christmas trees! Rich green color and lovely fragrance. Similar to Balsam, but has a fatter stem and needle. Likes cool, well-drained site, not dry and sandy. Soil pH 5.5-5.8 is ideal. 40-60'H x 25-35'W : Zones 3-7

CANADIAN HEMLOCK *Tsuga canadensis*: A stately reminder of old growth Wisconsin. This long-lived shade tolerant tree will make a thick screen when pruned. Not very drought or wind resistant. Grows best in well-drained locations similar to conditions preferred by the firs. 40-60'H x 20-30'W : Zones 3-7

AUSTRIAN PINE *Pinus nigra*: Dark green color and oval shape sets the Austrian apart from the others. Fragrant 4" needles in clusters of two. Once established, this fast grower tolerates heat and drought in nearly any soil condition, including high pH or clay. Popular ornamental or windbreak. 60'H x 20-40'W : Zones 4-7

RED PINE *Pinus resinosa*: One of our top sellers, this long-needled columnar pine is a fast grower, especially in sandy, dry areas. Self-pruning, a favorite of the paper companies for its disease resistance and future as a pulp producer. Try with Hybrid Poplar for a fast windbreak or add other Pine and Spruce for diversity. 60-80'+H x 30-40"W : Zones 2-6

They grow anywhere, even in dry and sandy locations. Excellent for erosion control and very drought tolerant once established. Interesting irregular shape. Full sun. 60'H x 40'W : Zones 3-7

Great timber producer or Christmas tree with good needle retention but little scent. Excellent deer cover. 60-80'H x 20-40'W : Zones 3-8

COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE *Picea pungens*: This tree is easy to grow in a variety of soil conditions and grows in partial shade, too! A Christmas tree which requires little shearing, color ranges from green to blue. 60-80'H x 10-20'W : Zones 2-7

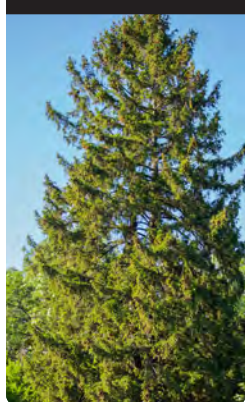

EMERALD GREEN ARBORVITAE *Thuja occidentalis - Smaragd*: One of today's best selling pyramidal arbs. Tight and erect in shape. Fast growing too. Cold hardy to -40F and also has excellent heat tolerance. Grows easily and is very adaptable to many soils. Grows to 15'-18' and is 3-4' wide : Zones 3-9

A very popular landscape and privacy screen tree. Exhibits good cold hardiness and drought tolerance. Grows to 15' tall, with a 6-10' spread : Zones 4-9
